What to expect

If your registration is current, you will receive a ballot in the mail about 21 days before each election in which you are eligible to vote; providing you time to review the ballot, research candidates and issues, and then vote at your convenience.

How and when to return your ballot

Use the provided return envelope to ensure your ballot will be counted, regardless of the return method you choose.

- **By Mail** – Return your ballot by mail. Ballots must be post marked no later than the Monday before the election (Monday, November 7, 2016) to be counted.
- **Drop Box** – Secure Ballot Drop Boxes will be available during business hours at select County locations through Monday, November 7, 2016. Ballots are regularly retrieved by election staff and delivered to the Clerk's Office for counting on Election Day.
- **Polling Locations – Election Day** – Two polling locations will be available on Election Day: Millard County Clerk's Office; 765 South Hwy 99, Ste. 6, Fillmore, UT and Millard County Satellite Offices; 71 South 200 West, Delta, UT. Bring your voted ballot, sealed in your return envelope, and use it as a "fast-pass" to avoid lines.
