

## OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE 2023 PRIMARY ELECTION

The 2023 Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, September 5, 2023. Ballots will be mailed to all eligible voters, approximately August 15, 2023.

Voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the precinct in which they are registered. The deadline for registering to vote is Friday, August 25, 2023, at 5:00 p.m.

Voters may verify their registration status, register to vote and/or view a sample ballot online at [www.vote.utah.gov](http://www.vote.utah.gov). Registered voters who do not receive a ballot, or need assistance, may visit one of the vote centers listed below during Early Voting or on Election Day.

If you cannot read or mark a mailed ballot, we can provide assistance or the use of a ballot marking device with accessible features (e.g., audio ballot, touch screen, large print, high contrast); or if you need assistance with voting your ballot or you have ballot issues, please contact the Millard County Clerk's Office 435-743-6223; 435-864-2440

Ballots may be returned the following ways: By mail (must be postmarked on or before Tuesday, September 5, 2023, to be counted); In person at one of the vote centers listed below; Dropped in one of the ballot drop boxes (before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day), ballot drop box locations can be found in the link below.
