## **Resolution # 2023-03**

## Cancellation of the 2023 Municipal General Election

- WHEREAS, the pursuant to Section 20A-1-202 of the Utah Code Annotated, as amended Lynndyl Town is required to hold an election for the election of persons to the Lynndyl Town Board; and
- WHEREAS, all municipal officers are elected in an at-large election; and
- WHEREAS, with respect to the 2023 election, the number of candidates for at-large positions does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have filed; and
- WHEREAS, there are no other municipal ballot propositions to be submitted for election; and
- WHEREAS, Section 20A-1-206 of the Utah Code Annotated, as amended, authorizes the Lynndyl Town Board to cancel the municipal election due to the foregoing circumstances; and
- WHEREAS, the Lynndyl Town Board has determined that cancellation of the election will eliminate unnecessary expenses and will be in the best interest of the public;
- THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Town Board of the Town of Lynndyl that:
  - 1. Richard Pyne and Mariffa Bishop are the only two people that have filed for two open 4-year councilmember positions on the Lynndyl Town Board and are therefore unopposed. Accordingly, the Lynndyl Town Board hereby declares the aforementioned to be elected to their respective positions with their respective terms to commence at 12:00 p.m. on the first Monday in January following the election.
  - 2 The Lynndyl Town Board hereby cancels the 2023 municipal election for Lynndyl Town and directs the recorder to give notice of cancellation of the municipal election for 2023 as follows:
    - A. Posting notice on the Statewide Electronic Voter Information website for 15 consecutive days before the day of the scheduled election.
    - B. Publishing notice at least twice in a newspaper of general circulation within the boundaries of Lynndyl Town prior to the day of the scheduled election.

C. Submitting a signed copy of this resolution to the Millard County Clerk's office and to the State of Utah Lieutenant Governor's Office.

This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its passage.
