

## OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE 2024 PRIMARY ELECTION

The 2024 Primary Election will be held on Tuesday, June 25, 2024. Ballots will be mailed to all eligible voters, approximately June 4, 2024. Sign up for text, email, or phone call notification for the status of your mailed ballot at: <http://ballottrax.utah.gov/>

Voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the precinct in which they are registered. The deadline for registering to vote is Friday, June 14, 2024, at 5:00 p.m.

Voters may verify their registration status, register to vote and/or view a sample ballot online at [www.vote.utah.gov](http://www.vote.utah.gov). Registered voters who do not receive a ballot, or need assistance, may visit one of the vote centers listed below during Early Voting or on Election Day.

If you cannot read or mark a mailed ballot, we can provide assistance or the use of a ballot marking device with accessible features (e.g., audio ballot, touch screen, large print, high contrast); or if you need assistance with voting your ballot or you have ballot issues, please contact the Millard County Clerk's Office 435-743-6223; 435-864-2440. Ballots may be returned the following ways: By mail (must be postmarked on or before Monday, June 24, 2024, to be counted); In person at one of the vote centers listed below; Dropped in one of the ballot drop boxes (before 8:00 p.m. on Election Day), ballot drop box locations can be found in the link below.
