UOCAVA ELECTION NOTICE

Uniform Military and Overseas Voters Act

Notice is hereby given that the Town of Leamington will hold a municipal election this fall to elect a Mayor and two Town Council Members. These are four-year terms, and the elected officials will take office on January 1, 2026. A candidate must be:

- A US citizen
- At least 18 years old
- A registered voter in the municipality
- A resident of Learnington Town for at least 12 months prior to the election

Each person seeking to become a candidate for municipal office shall file a declaration of candidacy form in person with the town recorder between Monday, June 2^{nd} and Friday, June 6^{th} by 5:00 p.m.

Ballots will be mailed at least 45 days prior to the Election date. Overseas/Military voters must postmark their ballot (or send via email) no later than 8:00 p.m. on Election Day - Utah local time.

Military and Overseas voters may contact <u>Federal Voting Assistance Program</u> (FVAP) which provides tools and resources to ensure that U.S. Citizens who want to vote can do so anywhere in the world.

The absentee voting process applies to you & you may use this site to vote as an absentee if you are:

- At least 18 years old.
- An active-duty member of the Uniformed Services or Merchant Marine absent from your voting residence.
- An eligible spouse or family member of an active-duty member of the Uniformed Services or Merchant Marine absent from your voting residence
- A U.S. citizen residing outside the country.
