RESOLUTION CANCELLING NOVEMBER 4, 2025, MUNICIPAL GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING EACH UNOPPOSED CANDIDATE ELECTED TO OFFICE

WHEREAS, Utah law provides that a municipal legislative body may cancel a local election if all municipal officers are elected in an at-large election and the number of municipal officer candidates, including any eligible write-in candidates for the at-large offices, does not exceed the number of open at-large municipal offices for which the candidates have filed.

WHEREAS, the two 4-year Council positions and the Mayor positions open for election, are atlarge positions and the number of candidates for these offices does not exceed the number of offices, for which the candidates have filed.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby resolved that pursuant to the provisions of the Utah Code Section 20A-1-206 that the November 4, 2025, local election for HOLDEN TOWN is hereby cancelled and the city Treasurer is directed to give notice of this cancellation as required by law.
