The Millard County General Plan shall be amended consistent with this prohibition. Any proposed amendments to this prohibition or any proposed resolution or ordinance that is inconsistent with this prohibition shall be referred to the voters of Millard County and shall not take effect unless approved by a majority of votes cast.
