<p>Shall the following become the law of Millard County: Land Use Amendments 2020 (Swine CAFO/CCAFO Prohibition) Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CAFO) and Confined Concentrated Animal Feeding Operations (CCAFO) involved in swine production shall be prohibited in all zones in Millard County. The Millard County General Plan shall be amended consistent with this prohibition. Any proposed amendments to this prohibition or any proposed resolution or ordinance that is inconsistent with this prohibition shall be referred to the voters of Millard County and shall not take effect unless approved by a majority of votes cast.
