

OFFICIAL PUBLIC NOTICE OF THE 2020 GENERAL ELECTION

The 2020 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 3, 2020. Ballots were mailed to all eligible voters, October 13, 2020. Voters must be of legal voting age, citizens of the United States, and reside in the precinct in which they are registered.

The deadline for registering to vote is Friday, October 23, 2020 at 5:00 p.m.. Voters may verify their registration status, register to vote and/or view a sample ballot online at www.vote.utah.gov. Registered voters who do not receive a ballot, or need assistance, may visit one of the vote centers listed below during Early Voting or on Election Day.

If you cannot read or mark a mailed ballot, we can provide assistance or the use of a ballot marking device with accessible features (e.g. audio ballot, touch screen, large print, high contrast). If you need assistance with voting your ballot or you have ballot issues, please contact the Millard County Clerk's Office 435-743-6223; 435-864-2440

Ballots may be returned the following ways:

- By mail, must be postmarked on or before Monday, November 2, 2020 to be counted.
- In person at one of the vote centers listed below.
- Dropped in one of the 24 hour drop boxes, also listed below.
