Voter Registration

To ensure you receive your ballot, check your registration and make sure it's current. If you have a PO Box, make sure we have it on file; otherwise, you may not get your ballot.

ID Required

If you have never voted in Millard County before, you MUST show proof of ID, to the Clerk's Office before your ballot can be counted.

Deadline Dates:

30 days before the election:

- Mailed Registrations
- Party Affiliation change

14 days before the election:

• Online & In-Person Registration

Millard County Is Still Voting By Mail

What to expect

If your registration is current, you will receive a ballot in the mail about 21 days before each election in which you are eligible to vote; providing you time to review the ballot, research candidates and issues, and then vote at your convenience.

How and when to return your ballot

Use the provided return envelope to ensure your ballot will be counted, regardless of the return method you choose. Be sure to sign the affidavit and provide a phone number or email in case there is an issue with your signature.

- **By Mail** Return your ballot by mail. Ballots must be post marked no later than the Monday before the election to be counted.
- <u>Drop Box</u> Secure Ballot Drop Boxes are located outside; 50 South Main St., Fillmore and 71 S 200 W, Delta for 24 hour convenience through 8:00 p.m., each election day. Ballots are regularly retrieved by election staff and delivered to the Clerk's Office for counting on Election Day.
- Polling Locations Election Day Two polling locations will be available on Election Day: Millard County Clerk's Office; 765 South Hwy 99, Ste. 6, Fillmore, UT and Millard County Satellite Offices; 71 South 200 West, Delta, UT, to accommodate voters who require ADA assistance and/or to remedy any issues with mailed ballots.
